

1987: partial preservation works;1993: the structural frame is substituted;2015-2018: complete preservation works.


Construction system

Steel and reinforced concrete frame with reinforced concrete "igloo" roof structure (the main "igloos" are made of concrete which was poured in situ, while the secondary "igloos" were prefabricated).


General plan Scale 1:1000


